Formative Assessment

- Assessments range from 15 to 60 randomized questions presented in a graphical format that children find motivating
- Curriculum-specific tests identify strengths and weaknesses of each student's abilities as well as progress and gains in achievement
- Tests show correct answers for any questions students may have missed in addition to periodic gains and specific remediation needs
- Assessment questions are randomized to ensure comprehension of material, not just rote memorization
